You'll be getting fresh organic vegies at a very low price. This is because we buy in bulk from Alfalfa House Food Co-op in Enmore, and they choose the best-priced, seasonal vegies and give us added support because we're a fellow co-op. You'll also be supporting a local food buying alternative and spreading the politics of co-operation. Alfalfa House prioritises suppliers who are ethical, environmental and local.

Jura Books is a not-for-profit, collectively-run community bookshop and library.
